Rules, Players, Pairings and Course Information

1. **Golf League Chair Terry Ray 901 596 2512**
2. **Money:** The 8-month fee is \$10.00 per person, all of which will be used for monthly prizes.
3. **Pairings and Dates:** Each team will play in the month and with the team specified on the pairings sheet. **Each foursome (not necessarily the first team listed) will be responsible** for coordinating its matches and arranging the tee times. The matches must be played on the course specified and should be played within the month specified. However, if you are going to be away, you may play your match before you go or after you return (see Rule #10 **Scorecards** below for monthly deadlines) even if it is not in the specified month. ***You may play one round only (see exception Rule #4) and not more to try to better your score.***
4. **Rain/Thunderstorms:** If you are forced off the course because of heavy rain and/or thunderstorms and lightening, you may complete your round at a later date. For example, if you completed four holes, you would use the scores for the first four holes from the original play date and the scores for the last five holes from the subsequent play date(s).
5. **Substitutes:** If you cannot play your match, you may get a substitute. **Substitutes must be current members of the Castleberry Circle Club Golf League.** Substitutes will receive the recognition and prize money, not the original member(s) who did not play. If you absolutely cannot find a substitute, you may play your match with three players. In that case, each of the 3 players would substitute for the missing player on 3 holes in rotation, i.e., Player 1 hits two balls on holes 1, 4, and 7; Player 2 hits two balls on holes 2, 5, and 8; and Player 3 hits two balls on holes 3, 6, and 9.
6. **Play Format:** The format for each monthly round is a 4-player scramble or best ball. Each player drives off of every tee. You pick the best ball and everyone hits from there (however, see Rule #8 **Drives** below). The score is the number of times the four people hit the ball to get it into the hole. (Example: Dee's ball was chosen after the tee shot—that's one shot. Lee hits the 2nd shot onto the green—that's two shots. Debbie puts the ball into the hole—that's three shots and you take a 3 for the hole.) No Mulligans allowed. Reminder—a "whiff" counts as your shot.
7. **Teeing Ground:** Men should use the middle tees and women the front tees. **Men over 80 may choose to play from the green tees.**
8. **Drives:** **You will not have to use everyone's drive, however, one person cannot have more than 4 drives.**
9. **Scorecards:** Mark your scorecard with date of match. Your scorecard must show the names of the players, team numbers, total score, and whose drive was used on each hole. See attached example of scorecard. If substitute(s) are used, list the name(s) of the substitute(s) in lieu of the originally scheduled player(s). **Turn in signed scorecards to: Terry Ray, 797 Castleberry Circle, no later than 6:00 p.m. the Friday prior to our monthly Castleberry Circle Club meetings.**
10. **Scores for foursomes failing to follow any of the above rules will not be considered.**
