Our neighborhood consists of 99 homes, and it is the only section of The Village of Bonnybrook south of Belvedere Blvd. So, although we are eligible to be members of the Bonnybrook Social Club (and many residents of "the circle" are) when the first residents moved into the circle in 2004, the Castleberry Circle Club was created to provide a smaller, more informal structure for neighborhood activities. There are no elected officers (all activities are supported by volunteers!) and no dues.
